(Englisch) The City of Duisburg decides further Corona protection measures

The Corona weekly incidence in Duisburg reached 201.5. In order to break infection chains, it is therefore crucial that every Duisburger reduces his personal contacts to a minimum.

The crisis unit of the city of Duisburg stipulates by a general decree that only two people may meet in public space.

The previous exceptions, which are laid down in the Corona Protection Ordinance of the Land of North Rhine-Westphalia, continue to apply.

This means that more than two people are only allowed to stay in public spaces if they are

- only for straight-line relatives, siblings, spouses, civil partners,
- exclusively for persons from a maximum of two different domestic communities,
- to accompany minors and persons in need of assistance or permanent groups of children who may be cared for in an institution within the meaning of the Corona Care Ordinance without respecting minimum intervals, or
- necessary meetings for care-related reasons

The new general decree of the city of Duisburg will apply from tomorrow, Thursday, 29 October.

The Civil and Public Order Office will monitor the new regulation, and a violation will be punished with a fine of 250 euros.

Please note:

Anyone can help slow down the spread. Protect yourself and others by applying the wellknown hygiene instructions. You can also use the official German Corona Warning app to help determine if you have come into contact with an infected person and there may be a risk of infection. This allows infection chains to be interrupted more quickly. The app is an offer from the federal government. Downloading and using the app are voluntary.
